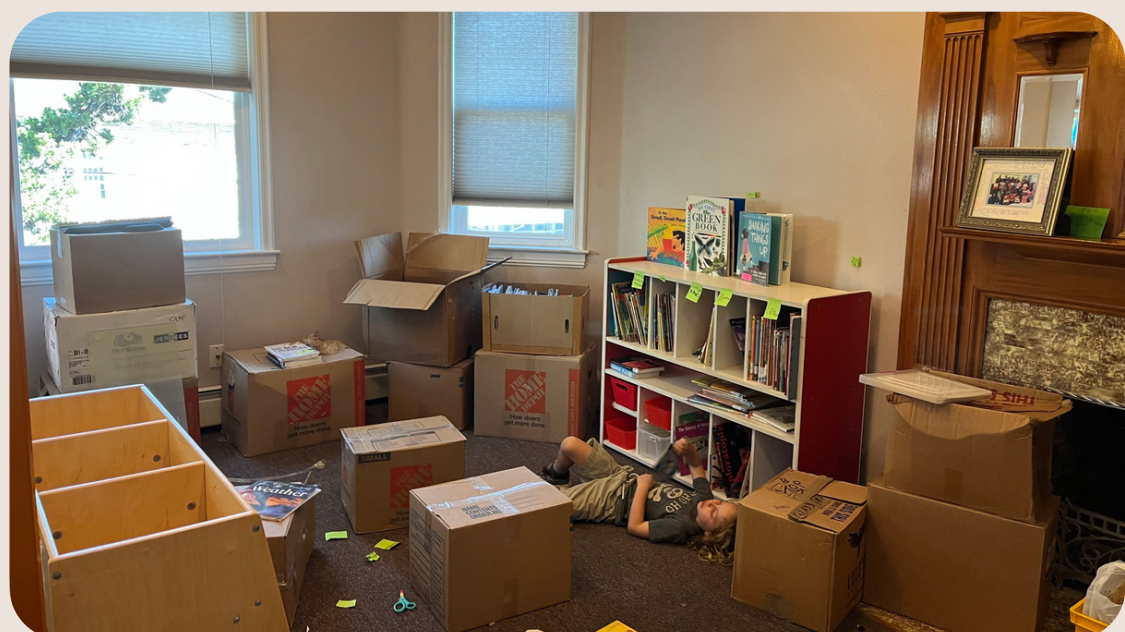


WordLab

Our teachers delivered small group outdoor reading and writing enrichment to elementary students in partnership with Berkeley Forest School.

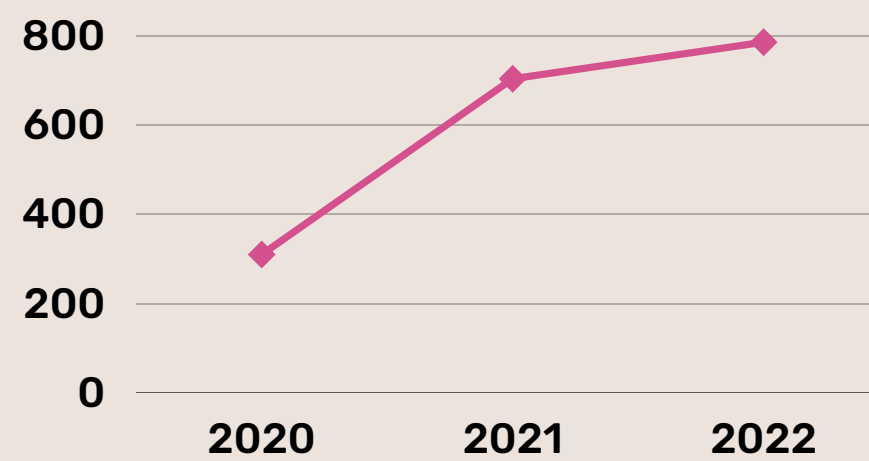
Nature Journaling Workshop
