

Memory Match!



Purpose:

- Practice noticing word parts – the more prefixes and suffixes you know, the more matches you will be able to make
- Recognizing prefixes and suffixes helps with spelling, reading, and understanding
- Sharpen your memory, playfully

Materials:

- Scissors
- Marker (if you want to make more cards)
- Curiosity

Instructions:

Objective: make as many matches as you can, while having fun.

Make it collaborative by working as a team to make the most matches in a certain amount of time.

1. Cut out the pieces – as many as you want but make sure to cut out both words in each pair. Mix up the cards and place them face down on a flat surface. The youngest player picks a card first and first says each letter out loud (announces it), then reads the whole word out loud.
2. The same player picks a second card and announces it and reads it aloud. If the cards match, that's a pair! That player collects their pair and the next player chooses two cards. If you pick two cards that are NOT a match, put the cards back where you found them.
3. There are blank cards included and you are encouraged to make your own word card pairs!
4. Most importantly, have fun!
